ITINERARY

DAY: 1

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport you will be met by an English speaking Springbok Atlas Tours & Safaris representative who will hand over your travel documents. From there you will be transferred to your Cape Town accommodation for a 4-night stay in the Mother City.

Cape Town is addictive and inspires discovery and has been voted as the best place in the world to visit by the prestigious New York Times. This vibrant multicultural city is a healthy mix of urban and convenient living, vibey day and night spots, nature and relaxation as well as the ocean and white sand beaches at your fingertips. Ride the revolving cable car to the sky on Table Mountain; shop at the V&A Waterfront, one of Africa's premier shopping destinations; stand on the edge of the world at Cape Point or delve into South Africa's past at Robben Island, the prison that once held one of the world's greatest heroes, Nelson Mandela. The "Mother City", the "Green City", the "Tavern of the Seas"...whatever name you give it, it stays beautiful and beckons to be explored—the more, the better.

Winchester Mansions is an iconic Cape Town hotel that sits opposite the Sea Point Promenade. The promenade is a popular space where locals come to work out, watch the sunset or simply feel the ocean spray on their face. The hotel is an example of original Cape Dutch architecture and has a distinct air of elegance and refinement in the Mother City. The hotel is home to Harvey's, one of the rare places in Cape Town where you can sit in style and watch as the Atlantic Ocean swallows the sun. Harvey's is a bistro by day and a restaurant by night and serves European inspired dishes. The Winchester Mansions Sunday Jazz brunch is legendary and features renowned and local talent. For the ultimate in pampering, there is a Ginkgo health and spa.

DAY: 2

Cape Peninsula Tour



Start your tour by heading towards Cape Point: the scenic drive will take you to the south western tip of the Cape Peninsula. Meander along the Atlantic coast, passing Sea Point, Camps Bay and the Twelve Apostles mountain outcrops. Once at Hout Bay you can take an optional boat trip to Duiker Island (for own account & time permitting) to see the Cape Fur Seals. Next we travel to the Cape Point Nature Reserve with its abundant fauna and flora and you have the opportunity to ride in the Funicular (optional and for your own account). We continue along False Bay with a stop at historic Simons Town to visit the Penguin colony at Boulders Beach (for own account) passing the village Fish Hoek and seaside Muizenberg. Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens is next before returning to Cape Town.

DAY: 3

Spend the day exploring the city and all it has to offer, from ascending the iconic Table Mountain, walking through the vibrant V&A Waterfront and relaxing on one of the various acclaimed Blue Flag beaches. The evening will be filled with song, dance and good food at the The Rockwell Dinner Theatre.

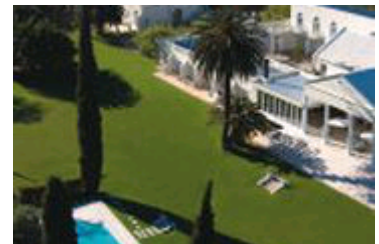
Paarl derives its name from a granite outcrop that stands on the crest of Paarl Mountain. This Cape Winelands town was founded in 1687 and is the third oldest settlement in South Africa. It has a rich cultural and historical heritage and has some of the finest examples of Georgian, Victorian, Edwardian and Cape Dutch architecture. Just outside of the town is the Drakenstein prison, where Nelson Mandela, the father of the South African nation and Noble Peace Prize winner spent his last years of his prison sentence and from where he began his 'long walk to freedom'. Paarl has a friendly country style hospitality and has a number of wine farms and estates as well as fine restaurants and coffee shops.

IN DAY: 5 OUT DAY: 7 (2 nights)

Accommodation at Cascade Country Manor in a Classic Room on a Bed and Breakfast basis

The 4 Star Cascade Country Manor, with an enviable location in the Paarl Winelands is set against a backdrop of the Klein Drakenstein Mountains and offers authentic country-style hospitality. Known for its superlative service, the venue also boasts an extensive range of luxury amenities including the on-site Cascade Spa and swimming pool. Surrounding the manor house are olive groves producing the fantastic oils the estate is renowned for and you can truly look forward to meals here, as the menu features traditional favourites made from locally sourced and fresh ingredients. There is something for everyone in the vicinity from championship golf courses, museums and monuments to Butterfly World, the Drakenstein Lion Park, and world class wine estates.

DAY: 6

Take the day at your own stride. Relax in the comfort of Cascade Manor's spa with a beautiful treatment, take a stroll to the waterfall 300 m away, plunge in the swimming pool or unwind in the indoor heated pool, sauna and steam room. Alternatively, take a drive through the historic town of Paarl and visit wine farms such as Fairview and Spice Route.

DAY: 7

After breakfast depart for **Oudtshoorn**—the “Ostrich Capital” of the world and the largest town in the Klein Karoo region, a semi-desert place with a reputation for its inspiring natural splendour. The ostrich feather boom made instant millionaires of ostrich farmers in the early 1900's, when feathers were a sought-after fashion piece by the likes of royalty and the upper crust. Feather palaces were built in and around the town of Oudtshoorn and they even went as far as to have ostriches pull Santa's sleigh at Christmas. Today, Oudtshoorn is alive with activity that includes, the Cango Caves, the Wildlife Ranch, nature adventures and museums. Visit the Safar Ostrich Farm to learn more about these intriguing animals.

IN DAY: 7 OUT DAY: 8 (1 night)

Accommodation at La Plume Guest House in a Luxury Room (FIT only) on a Bed and Breakfast basis

La Plume Boutique Guest House is on a working ostrich, alfalfa and cattle farm and has the most inspiring views of the Swartberg Mountains. The guest house itself is a charming 1902 Victorian Homestead that exudes an old world elegance and grace. The owner of La Plume has poured her passion and creativity into the decor of this beautiful guesthouse and is evident in the antiques that adorn the property. English style buffet breakfasts are a great way to start the day and dinners are held in the candlelit dining room where traditional home-cooked cuisine is served. Every detail at La Plume Boutique Guest House has been lovingly tended to, creating a property that will envelop you in luxury.

DAY: 8

Knysna is found towards the end of the Garden Route in the Western Cape. The forested town of Knysna grew around its large, warm-watered lagoon and is still the town's principal showcase. The lagoon is a protected marine reserve. Outdoor features like beaches, rivers, mountains and lakes orbit around the town and with it a host of activities. The Knysna Heads are a mammoth attraction of sheer cliffs that guard the entry into the lagoon: Many ships have perished in an attempt to sail past the heads, and today scuba divers can still see the remnants of the Paquita that sank in 1903. A paved pathway leads to the top of the eastern head and makes a terrific viewpoint and spectacular photos. The town itself is also an amalgamation of wealth and bohemian artistry with something for every kind of traveller.

IN DAY: 8 OUT DAY: 10 (2 nights)

Accommodation at Belvidere Manor in a Garden Classic on a Bed and Breakfast basis

Belvidere Manor is arguably one of South Africa's most beloved and romantic getaways. It is found along the most famous route in the world, the Garden Route, where nature inspires and is on the west shores of the Knysna Lagoon. Belvidere Manor not only offers rest and relaxation in pristine surroundings but also good food and joviality at either Caroline's Bistro or the Bell Tavern. Caroline's Bistro is named after the first mistress of Belvidere and the Bell Tavern is Knysna's smallest pub that is now where the original farmhouse used to be. Knysna is also a hub of activity and offers everything from horse-riding and hiking to fishing, abseiling and paragliding. It's the perfect mixture of adventure and peace.

DAY: 9

Explore Knysna! Walk through the town's waterfront and try some well-known Knysna Oysters, consider a lagoon cruise and enjoy the views from the Knysna Heads.

DAY: 10

After breakfast depart for the Big-5 Pumba Private Game Reserve in the malaria-free Eastern Cape for a change to get close to African Wildlife.

In the malaria-free safari destination of the Eastern Cape Province, Pumba Private Game Reserve is home to two 5 Star luxury lodges. Set amongst grassland, fynbos, forest and savannah landscapes, the reserve is a Mecca for wildlife and nature lovers as well as birdwatchers. There are nearly 60 different species of mammal roaming the landscape here including the Big 5 and approximately 300 species of bird. A highlight is a view of the rare free-roaming white lions. This is a destination for discerning guests looking for a quality experience combining luxurious accommodation, outstanding cuisine and superlative game viewing. Other features of the reserve include access to the mini-gym, archery, bass fishing, Soul Spa and guided walking safaris.

DAY: 11

Spend the day exploring the bushveld with 2 daily game drives and relax in the comfort of your lodge set amongst the dense veld and overlooking Lake Cariega.

DAY: 12

After an early morning game drive and breakfast, depart for Port Elizabeth.
